

Call for Art

How to submit work for consideration for future exhibits:

Slides:

Submit duplicate slides (no originals) of up to eight (8) works that are two-dimensional works or that can be hung as 2-D. Slides should be in a plastic sheet, labeled with your name, title, date, medium and dimensions of artwork. (Indicate the top front of your work.)

Statements/Documentation:

Include a typed artist statement, a typed slide list/documentation of work and separate slide narrative, not to exceed 400 words, explaining the connection, if any, between each slide and one or more of four themes: "Community," "Diversity," "Service," "Spirit," — themes of our exhibits. A resumé and other promotional materials are also welcome. If you have online versions of your art, please refer us to your website.

Selection Process:

Acceptance is the responsibility of the curator working with a committee. Artwork, once accepted, may eventually be deleted, replaced or other works solicited for any or no reason (usually, matters of space or other physical limitations). Selection criteria include practical and thematic as well as artistic considerations. You will be notified by phone or

email with further instructions if your work is accepted for an exhibit.

If Accepted:

Artists selected sign agreements acknowledging understanding of all terms. Arrangements for getting the work to the exhibit and back to the artist will be made at that time.

Future Exhibits:

Enclose self-addressed, stamped envelope (SASE) for safe return of slides if you want them returned. Slides will otherwise be kept on file as resources for future exhibits. A separate "Call for Art" will be issued for each future exhibit; please let us know how you heard about this exhibit, and indicate if you would like future "Calls for Art" sent directly to you by mail or email.
